The Distinguished Texan in Agriculture Award recognizes and honors agricultural leaders who have distinguished themselves by reaching a significant level of accomplishment and who possesses the highest standards of integrity and character for their outstanding leadership and significant contributions to Texas agriculture.

**N**ominations may be submitted utilizing the attached nomination form or nominations may be submitted in narrative form and should include the following information: nominees name, home and/or business mailing address and telephone; education (including a listing of schools with dates of attendance, degrees received, including honorary degrees); business, public service and professional awards; noteworthy research, inventions, publications or professional/business accomplishments; and a brief citation (not more than 200 words) which describes the nominees accomplishments as they relate to his/her contributions on behalf of the Texas agricultural industry and community along with a current biography, resume or curriculum vitae. Letters of support are welcomed and encouraged (maximum of 3 letters per nomination). Posthumous nominations will be accepted.
