Texas A&M AgriLife Research is pleased to issue a call for nominations for Faculty Fellows within Texas A&M AgriLife Research. Established in 1998, this program recognizes outstanding and productive faculty who have contributed to the scholarly creation and dissemination of new knowledge through exceptional research leadership and grantsmanship through their respective discipline. Over the past sixteen years, 59 individuals have been recognized with this honor; a list of Faculty Fellow and Senior Faculty Fellows is available on the awards website.

Your department/unit is invited to submit nominations by utilizing the attached nomination summary. All Associate Professors and Professors who hold a budgetary appointment with Texas A&M AgriLife Research are eligible for nominations as a Faculty Fellow. Fellows receive a framed certificate designating the honor and cash award of \$4,000. In developing your nominations, we have also provided some "helpful hints" for your consideration based on input from former members of the Faculty Fellows Review Panel.

These awards will be presented in 2016.
