Texas A&M AgriLife Research is pleased to issue a call for nominations for the Early Career Award for Research Excellence. Established in 2019 as a recognition to Dr. William A. Dugas upon his retirement, this \$5,000 annual award honors an early career AgriLife Research Faculty member who has “made an exceptional contribution to the agency and research in the prior year.”

Your department/unit is invited to submit nominations by utilizing the attached nomination form. All Assistant Professors, Associate Professors, Professors, Assistant Research Scientists, Associate Research Scientists and Research Scientists who hold a budgetary appointment with Texas A&M AgriLife Research are eligible for nomination for this award. The recipient of this award will receive a framed certificate designating the honor and a cash award of \$5,000.
